God Is Sovereign

Any genuine Christian does not question the sovereignty of God. However, the infinite manifestations of this attribute of God are often missed. The following observations will briefly overview, according to the Scriptures, some of the things God had to accomplish for the birth of Jesus to happen.

Joseph Moves To Nazareth

"And all went to be taxed, every one into **his own city**. (4) And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called **Bethlehem**; (because he was of the house and lineage of David:)" (Luke 2:3-4)

Joseph apparently was born in Bethlehem. When Caesar issued the taxation decree, Joseph had to return to "*his own city*" to obey the edict. This fact indicates that he was originally from Bethlehem.

This being the case, at some point, **Joseph moved to Nazareth**. The Bible does not tell us

how God had arranged this relocation. Still, assuredly God did so. **Mary lived in Nazareth**, making it necessary for Joseph to likewise dwell in Nazareth. Suffice it to say God orchestrated (not forced) Joseph and Mary's lives so they would be where they needed to be.

In those days, that would have been almost miraculous. Transportation was not like today (no cars), and the trip was approximately 70 miles. Why would Joseph relocate to Nazareth? No one knows. But God made sure he was there for Mary. God is Sovereign!

A Virgin Gets Pregnant

"Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel." (Isaiah 7:14)
