Can godly leaders **confirm** the testimony of Christ in you?

"Even as the testimony of Christ was confirmed in you:" (1 Corinthians 1:6)

The testimony of Christ or His servants is nothing of which to be **ashamed**!

"Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God;" (2

Timothy 1:8)

Testifying of Jesus might get you exiled.

"I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ." (Revelation 1:9)

It's All About Jesus – A Closer Look

"And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death." (Revelation 12:11)

The method to overcome the enemy is <u>JESUS</u>! So again, it is entirely about Jesus.

Overcome - by the Blood of the Lamb.

Obviously, this is referencing Jesus and His sacrificial death as the Lamb of God. His death fully satisfies the wrath of God against sin.

<u>Overcome</u> - by the word of our testimony. Again, this is totally about Jesus. What is it that we are supposed to testify regarding? Our witness is of the salvation and changed life we have received because of Jesus.

<u>Overcome</u> - by **not loving our lives even unto death**. This concept would be unthinkable if not for the reality of Jesus Christ. Who would give up their life for Christ if they had no relationship with God?

Conclusion

You are speaking a testimony. If not in words, your actions are your witness.

#### **Rags To Riches**

"The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: (17) And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together." (Romans 8:16

-17)

## **Riches Back To Rags**

"For if **after they have escaped** the pollutions of the world **through the knowledge of the Lord**  and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning. (21) For it had been better

for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them. (22) But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb, The dog is turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire." (2 Peter 2:20-22)

This passage is very sobering and should be considered seriously.

Imagine having been freed from the bondage of sin and this ungodly world through knowing Jesus and returning to the vomit from which one had been released. It is hard to believe that people would choose to embrace what the world has to offer over God's salvation. But it happens.

Pastors, worship leaders, Bible teachers, and many others who were once actively involved in service to the Lord have returned to the world's ways.

As believers, we must take <u>the many warnings in</u> <u>Scripture very seriously</u>.

# **Come Home Prodigal**

"I will arise and **go to my father**, and will say unto

him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and before thee, (19) And am no more worthy to be called thy son: make me as one of thy hired servants. (20) And he arose, and came to his father. But when he was yet a great way off, his father saw him, and had compassion, and ran, and fell on his neck, and kissed him."

(Luke 15:18-20)
